We need to think about which way we might turn.
Make a mobile to show that this story marked a moment of decision

You will need: pens, four lolly sticks, ball of string or wool, scissors.

- On the first lolly stick, write 'Jesus' on the left-hand side and 'Jerusalem' on the right.
- On the second, write 'Disciples' on the left-hand side and 'Jesus' on the right.
- On the third, write 'Crowds' on the left-hand side and put a question mark on the right.
- On the fourth stick, write 'Me' on the left-hand side and add another question mark to the right.
- Tie the end of the string round the middle of the fourth stick. Leave a gap and then tie the third stick above. Repeat with the second and first sticks.
- To finish tie a loop above the sticks, so the mobile can be hung up.

Talk about Jesus deciding to go to Jerusalem and the disciples deciding to follow him. The crowds at the Passover festival had an opportunity to think about who Jesus was, and we do too. The mobile reminds us that we need to think about which way we might turn.
